Need Constant Pruning Keeping tomato plants pruned and tied to stakes or a fence needs constant attention. At the joint where each leaf grows on the main stem a branch will develop, and this must be cut or pinched off before it is four inches long...

Require Sun And Water Tomatoes require full sun and regular watering. When the soil is allowed to dry out, with fruit set, a black decay spot known as "blossom-end-rot" may develop on the fruit.
